BAC RESOLUTION ON THE RECOMMENDED MODE OF PROCUREMENT

RESOLUTION No. 07 Series of 2021

WHEREAS, the City Social Welfare and Development Office and Gender and Development Office issued a letter requesting for an Emergency Procurement for the Purchase Request No. 21-0431 dated March 24, 2021.

WHEREAS, the total budget of Ten Million Pesos (Php10,000,000.00) is allocated for the implementation of the following chargeable against the funds available:

Food and Non-Food Items – Php10, 000,000.00

WHEREAS, the letter of request aims to deliver necessary funding support for the immediate provision of essential foods for confirmed cases, persons under investigation and monitoring to boost their immune system while they are in self-isolation or in quarantine protocol.

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee received a Purchase Request from the CSWD for the Procurement of Rice and Groceries with a total estimated cost of Eight Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Eight Pesos (P898,008.00);

WHEREAS, under the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", there are Alternative Methods of Procurement;

WHEREAS, under Section 53 of the said IRR, Negotiated Procurement is an Alternative Method of Procurement whereby it is a method of procurement of goods, infrastructure projects, and consulting services, whereby the procuring entity directly negotiates a contract with a technically, legally, and financially capable supplier, contractor, or consulting;

WHEREAS, among the modes of Negotiated Procurement is in Emergency Cases where it is resorted to in case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or other cases where immediate action is necessary to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public services, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities.

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed and issued Proclamation No. 1021 "DECLARING EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF THE STATE OF CALAMITY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES DUE TO CORONA VIRUS DISEASE 2019";

WHEREAS, in view thereof, the entire country is presently under a State of Calamity;

WHEREAS, under the said Proclamation, Local Government Units are enjoined to render full assistance to and cooperation with each other and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate disaster response aid and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of Covid-19;
